



FAMILY GUIDELINES

Welcome – from our family to yours.

We're delighted to welcome families back to Meet Me There Eco Lodge. We want everyone — young and old — to feel comfortable, relaxed and at home. These guidelines help families enjoy their stay while being considerate of other guests and our environment.

Sleeping arrangements:

- **Children under 5:** Welcome to share your bed at no additional charge. If an extra bed is required this would incur a charge of GHS 350 per night.
- **Children aged 5–12:** An additional **GHS 350 per night in the same room.**
- **Maximum occupancy:** Rooms accommodate a maximum of **3 people (2 adults + 1 child)**. Please contact us before booking if you are travelling with an infant or have specific sleeping requirements.
- **Children over 12:** We ask that they have their own room. Two children are welcome to share a room together.
- **Rooms close together:** We recommend **Except God & Moon, Chief & Honeymoon Suites, or Sunset & Sunrise Suites**. Please let us know your preference when booking.
- **Coming soon:** We're developing a dedicated family room over the next 12 months, sleeping **4–6 guests**.

A peaceful place

Please help children enjoy and explore the lodge while being respectful of other guests and shared spaces.

Yoga & the Summer House

Yoga takes place **7:30–8:30am** and **5:30–6:30pm**. Everyone is welcome; children attending or nearby are asked to respect the calm and quiet atmosphere.

Learning Centre & Library

Children are very welcome. Please use this space for paints, crafts and other creative activities, and help younger children tidy up afterwards.

Our gardens

Please keep children out of planted garden beds for their safety and to protect our delicate flowers and plants.

Beach & lagoon

The little beach in front of the lagoon and the beach beyond the lagoon are ideal for play and exploration. The bar is primarily an adult relaxation space, so please keep children's play to the designated beach and outdoor areas.

Water safety

Please supervise children around water at all times. The lagoon and surrounding water areas are natural environments and are not supervised swimming areas. Parents/guardians remain responsible for children's safety.
